Show Procedures

- · Shows will start promptly at 8:30 AM.
- Ranch Horse Pleasure Pattern and Trail will be run in a separate arena and will be judged by a second judge.
- In-Hand Trail will begin at 11:00 AM with age division trail to start immediately afterwards.
- You need to make your way to the secondary arenas during these times.

Club Rules:

- Rider's age group is based on rider's age as of January 1, 2018.
- · Walk/Trot riders may not have won a ribbon in a Walk/Trot/Canter class in the last year.
- · Daily high points are calculated on a one horse/one rider basis.
- Longe Line is for Horses and Ponies 2 years old and younger that are not being shown in a Walk/Trot/ Canter class. In-Hand Trail is for Miniature Horses and Horses and Ponies 2 years old and younger not being shown under saddle.
- Exhibitors may enter any halter class they qualify for but only one will count towards daily high point.
- Unregistered horses must enter the class best corresponding to their breed type.
- · We reserve the right to combine classes with fewer than five entries.
- SEI/ASTM helmet's are strongly recommended for riders 18 & under
- · Each horse/rider team may compete in only one division per show.
- Each horse/rider team must use the same back number each show for points to accumulate towards year-end awards.
- · Rider may not use the same number with a different horse, you must use a new number.
- A current negative Coggin's test is required for any horse on the show grounds.
- Year end points only accumulate after membership is paid.
- To qualify for yearend awards members must show in at least three shows and complete required work credits. Exhibitors best (highest pointed) five of six shows count towards year end awards.
- Members will only receive one year end award per division.
- Any person entering the grounds absolves and discharges HWSC, Inc. and any person connected
 with the show from any loss, damage or injury to himself, herself, property or animal. Horses
 endangering exhibitors and or others may be asked to leave the arena or grounds at the discretion of
 the judge or show management. Unsportsmanlike conduct or any other form of misconduct that is
 irresponsible, illegal, indecent, profane, intimidating, threatening or abusive is prohibited. Show
 management may immediately expel individuals exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct from the show
 grounds.
- · Returned check fee is \$35.00.
- Refunds are at the discretion of the show management.
- If a severe weather warning is still in effect at 7:00 AM or goes into effect prior to show time, the show will be cancelled. Show management has the right to cancel if severe weather occurs during the show.
